

Our current medication policy, Rule 5.15 states...

Administration of medications during school hours is discouraged. The term "medication" includes both prescription and non-prescription ("over-the-counter") medication. All prescription and non-prescription medication administered by the school at the elementary, middle and high school level must be directed by a physician who has determined that a student's health and well-being requires medication during school hours. All non-prescription medication in the possession of students at the middle and high school not administered by the school requires written permission from the parent to the school.

Due to the current Zika outbreak, we will temporarily modify the medication policy to allow parents at the elementary level to bring an insect repellent to the school with their child's name written on the container for application by staff before going outside. We will continue our policy for middle and high school students in that they may self-carry and self-apply insect repellent with written permission from the parent.
