WHAT IS CHARMS?

HOW DO I LOG ON TO CHARMS?

- 1. Log on to www.charmsoffice.com and locate "Log In" in the upper right corner. Click on Parent/Students/Members.
- 2. Enter the school code (Switzerland) then click "Enter Charms".
- 3. Enter your ID NUMBER in the StudentAreaPassword field. Your ID = First Name, Last Initial and high school graduation year Ex: MaryL26.
- 4. Change Password to a personal password.

HOW DO I USE CHARMS?

Please use Charms to:

- 1. Update your info. Your EMAIL ADDRESS is the #1 priority. Please also update your preferred contact phone number and STUDENT'S t-shirt size.
- 2. Check the online calendar for performances and upcoming deadlines.
- 3. Sign up to volunteer
