- Applicant must demonstrate academic initiative and maintain a 3.5 average throughout the duration of membership.

II. Service

- Applicant is expected to participate in a fundraiser that will raise money for a charity and/or school-improvement project.
- Applicant is expected to complete community/academic service hours. All members must have a total of 15 service hours. Service hours must be completed and turned in **by January 29th, 2027**, in order to participate in our NJHS field trip.

III. Leadership

- Applicant must demonstrate leadership in promoting school activities, contribute ideas that improve the civic life of the school, exemplify a positive attitude, be dependable, and be a role model for peers.

IV. Character

- Applicant must consistently uphold principles of morality, ethics, kindness, reliability, and trustworthiness. In addition, the applicant must agree to observe school rules and show courtesy, concern, and respect for others.

Additional Responsibilities:

- ✓ To enroll in and maintain a fully academic curriculum.
- ✓ To attend regular, special, and committee meetings.
- ✓ To participate in NJHS special projects and fundraisers.
- ✓ To actively demonstrate and develop qualities of leadership, service, and character.
- ✓ To pay annual dues, not to exceed \$30.
